The first purchase was some beautiful bespoke lounge furniture to replace the 20

year old couches. The Lions Club contributed to this purchase, as did the funds from the Trivia Night earlier in the year.

We have also purchased new outdoor chairs which should arrive soon, and installed air conditioning in staff offices.

The Yarra Ranges Council has included Caladenia in the capital budget this year—and has repaired and repainted the whole of the outside of Meadowbank House, including the Gazebo. It's been a huge job and I apologise for the inconvenience whilst the painters and workmen have been around.

Inside the offices we are looking at a rearrangement of offices to accommodate the needs of our growing staff.
